A FREE program for schools in AEP Ohio service territory

Science teachers are invited to be part of an exciting program, e3smart. Facilitated by the Ohio Energy Project, participating teachers in grades 5-12 will:

- Attend a one-day professional development.
- Receive a kit of equipment to teach the science of energy and efficiency through classroom labs.
- Receive student energy kits. Students will be empowered as the “energy leaders” of their families by installing energy efficient measures at home.

Benefits for Educators

- Over \$2,000 worth of curriculum, classroom equipment and student kits correlated to the Ohio Academic Content Standards.
- \$100 stipend for participating in and completing the program
- Optional semester hour graduate credit from Ashland University—available at a reduced rate
- CEU documentation
- Save energy and utility costs at school and home

Program Requirements

- Your school must be in AEP Ohio electric service territory
- Attend a one-day professional development in August
- Utilize all of the lessons and curriculum in the classroom
- Submit evaluation data by April 15, 2011

Frequently Asked Questions 2010-2011 e3smart

Q: When will I be notified if I am selected as a participant?

A: Registration will be open until May 1, 2010. You will be notified by June 4, 2010 if you are selected. Applications will continue to be received as spots remain available. All confirmations will be done via your school email address.

Q: How is the e3smart different from the Be E³ Smart Program?

A: e3smart is the same program as Be E³ Smart; it is just under a different name.

Q: Will I receive my deposit back?

A: Yes. Your \$50 deposit reserves your spot at the professional development. Your check will not be cashed and you will receive it at the completion of the workshop. Your deposit is only forfeited if you do not attend the professional development.

Q: Do I have to attend the professional development workshop if I attended last year?

A: No. Returning teachers will attend a celebration dinner where they will receive updates and new materials, and share their stories.

Q: How do you select participants?

A: Priority will be given to the following teachers:

- Teachers who completed the program last year and submitted their evaluation data.
- Only one grade level per school district will be selected.
- Only participants teaching in schools served by AEP Ohio will be selected.
- 5th-12th grade science teachers.
- The number of teachers per school and/or district will be determined by the total number of applications received.

Q: What is the cost for the e3smart program?

A: All classroom materials, student kits and lunch during the professional development are **FREE!**

Q: How much graduate credit is available and how much does it cost?

A: One semester hour from Ashland University at \$150 per hour. To fulfil the required amount of 10 contact hours, you must complete 3 additional hours through an OEP program.
